Shortcuts to Natural Lawn Care

- 1. Mow your lawn at 3 inches or higher.
- 2. Leave your grass clippings on your lawn.
- 3. Spot treat weeds instead of spraying the entire lawn.
- 4. Keep fertilizer off sidewalks and driveways.
- 5. Test your soil for fertilizer needs.
- 6. Water no more than 1 inch per week, including rain.

5 Ways to Help Reduce Air Pollution

- 1. **Take Care of your Car.** Changing the oil and checking the tire pressure can improve gas mileage and could reduce your car's emissions by more than half.
- 1. **Trip Chain.** Combine errands into one trip. Starting a car that has been sitting for an hour or longer pollutes up to five times more than a warm engine.
- **2. Don't top off the tank.** The extra gas fumes increase ground level ozone.
- **3. Get fuel when it's cool.** Refueling in the evening can prevent gas fumes from heating up and creating ground level ozone.
- 4. Know before you go. Get travel updates before you leave to avoid traffic congestion.
- **5. Share a ride.** Carpooling a few times a week will decrease traffic congestion, reduce pollution and save money.
